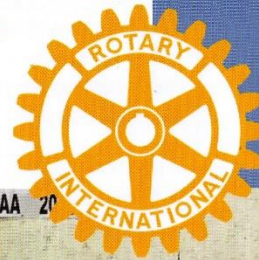
This exciting event is generously supported by Taos' leading chefs, including the award winning Taos High School culinary arts program and sponsored by leading Taos businesses.

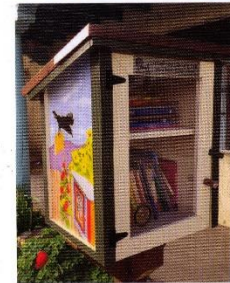
Taos Milagro Rotary Literacy Projects

For the Love of Reading

is a Rotary coordinated literacy project in which we are presently reading to K through 3rd grade children at Ranchos Elementary school. For 1/2 hour once or twice a week the children are read to individually at their pace and ability. Books are given out every three weeks for the children to own and help encourage home reading. We are hoping to expand the program to other schools in the county.



Little Free Libraries



Rotary has placed 15 Little Free Libraries in Taos County in low income areas and housing projects, high visibility areas, Medical clinics, Trailer court housing, and isolated areas. Thousands of books have been distributed, mostly children's books to encourage reading but includes all ages.
